The survey also showed that a quarter of U.S. adults have never used a computer, set a VCR to record a TV show or programmed favorite station on their car radio. 1,000 adults and 500 teens across the country participated in this study. Teenagers are more technically literate than adults, with 92 percent of the teenage group feeling more comfortable using a variety of technical devices, compared to 74 percent of the adults group.
